New and upgraded substations to boost power supply

The Steve Tshwete electrical department uses a 20-year master plan as a guide to provide for the present and future electricity requirements. For the financial 2010/11, three main substations have been upgraded over the past three years to expand power supply to Mhluzi and surrounding areas.

A new substation has been erected at Aerorand over a three year period to supply the new industrial area and the new mall at a value of R59 000 000.

Nasaret substation is being erected over three financial years to supply low cost housing at Nasaret, Extension 24, 22 and Rockdale at a cost R37 000 000.

There are 2365 houses being electrified for new housing development. The value of the project is R19 000 000.

Upgrading of electrical networks includes replacements of redundant equipment to the value of R8 000 000 to improve sustainability of electricity supply.
