ALIENATION OF PROPERTY BY MEANS OF AN UNSOLICITED BID

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 21 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 as amended read together with Section 113 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003 and Section 44 of the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy that the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality intends to lease Portions of the Remainder of Portion 27 of the Farm Middelburg Town and Townlands measuring 500m² in extent ("the property") to I. Manzini for light industrial activities at an amount of R0.65c per square metre (Sixty Five Cents per square metre) per month per portion excluding VAT.

The alienation of the property is not open for competitive bidding because:

- i) The person who made the proposal will be prejudiced if a competitive bidding process is followed.

The potential benefits of the acceptance of this unsolicited bid are:

- i) That additional income for Council will be generated.
