

## **STEVE TSHWETE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY**

### **ALIENATION OF PROPERTY BY MEANS OF AN UNSOLICITED BID**

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 79(18) of the Local Government Ordinance 17 of 1939 as amended read together with Section 21 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 as amended, Section 113 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003 and Section 41 of the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy that the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality intends to lease Erf 9038 Mhluzi Extension 5 ("the property") measuring 200m<sup>2</sup> in extent to S M Mapengu for selling of vegetables at an amount of R180.00 (One Hundred and Eighty Rand) per month including VAT with 6% escalation per annum reviewable 3 yearly.
