C3 SCOPE OF WORKS / SPECIFICATIONS

1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

The Steve Tshwete Local Municipality (STLM) is experiencing a much higher population growth rate (4.4% annual population growth rate in 2016) than other towns in Mpumalanga or at national level. Thus, more services and businesses to increase the revenue base are needed to cover the growing demand and ease the pressure on the municipality. The greater Middelburg market has multifaceted demands with regard to infrastructure, roads, electricity, water and housing. It is therefore imperative for the municipality to broaden its revenue base and increase the number of businesses paying rates and taxes.

STLM supports and tries to stimulate business activities and growth through its Local Economic development (LED) strategy and support to township economy. To accelerate these developments and strengthen the efforts, a sound data and knowledge base of especially micro and small businesses in townships and rural areas is needed. It is against this background that the municipality wants to strengthen its support to SMMEs to stimulate local economic development and enable a vibrant township economy. A specific township revitalization strategy is being drafted and will be launched soon.

Only limited studies that would inform the municipality on SMME development and business conditions have been conducted in the townships and rural areas. This study will serve as a baseline for the development of a revitalization township strategy as well as for a revised strategy on LED. So far, plans do not link the emerging and township-based businesses with the industrial development strategy. Part of the challenges include the following:

- ✓ No tailor-made programmes for township and rural area business exist that support township and rural economic development
