C3 SCOPE OF WORKS / SPECIFICATIONS

1. SCOPE OF WORKS OF THE SERVICES REQUIRED

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The principal features of the scope of works do not limit the responsibility of the *contractor*. He shall perform all work and furnish all labour, equipment and material to ensure the satisfactory operation of the substation. Material and devices, which are normally part of the supplied equipment and are essential for the proper operation of all equipment or are necessary for the proper functioning of the whole installation, shall be supplied even if not explicitly called for in these specifications.

The *contractor* will provide the following:

1. All plant, material, hand tools, transport and labour required for the construction and commissioning of the works.
2. Operating manuals and training as specified.

The Works will consist of the following:

1. Painting work
2. Installation of tiles

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE SITE AND ACCESS

2.1 Location of site

2.2 Access to site

Tenderer's must allow for all conditions on site in their tenders, since extra claims arising from difficult site conditions in respect to transport, handling, loading, off-loading, labour, housing, etc., will not be entertained. Access routes to the site shall at all times be kept serviceable, or alternatives shall be provided. These include road entrances that may have to be kept closed overnight.

PS3 DETAILS OF THE WORKS

3.1 Brief description of works

This section covers the general technical specifications for the construction of a new ablution facility. Where the specification refers to items not required the specific clauses shall be ignored.

3.2 Nature of stratum on site

The underground cable will be installed in a rocky area and tenderers need to make provision for "hard rock". Existing services such as water and sewer pipelines need to be exposed every 20 meters before excavations take place to prevent damages.

The contractor shall note that, unless provided for in terms of the scheduled payment items of the project specifications, measurement and payment shall be in accordance with the specified excavation, construction and filling works, irrespective of the method used for achieving these cross sections and dimensions, and that the tendered rates and amounts shall include full compensation for all special equipment and construction methods and for all difficulties encountered when working in confined areas and narrow widths, and at or around obstructions, and that no extra payment shall be made nor

shall any claim for additional payment be considered in such cases.

3. PAYMENTS
