In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for the upgrading of the inletworks at the Boskrans Waste Water Treatment Works.

Tenders are hereby invited for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase Upgrading of Boskrans Waste Water Treatment Works – Package 2 New inlet works pumpstation – civil , mechanical and electrical works, in the Steve Tshwete municipal region. The works comprises of both the civil works and the mechanical electrical portion of the works. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 6CE/6ME or higher.**

Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

**Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked** "TENDER NO. BS01/06/2017: 2<sup>ND</sup> PHASE UPGRADING OF BOSKRANS WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS – PACKAGE 2 NEW INLET WORKS PUMPSTATION– CIVIL, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL WORKS" with the name of the tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before 12H00 on 2017/08/08. The tenders will be opened in public.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the gate of the Boskrans WWTW Inletworks (lat 25.738606°, long 29.449324°) MIDDELBURG on Wednesday, 2017/07/19, starting at 10h00 hrs. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

*Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby 65 points has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the supply chain management policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.*

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person , of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Contractors who have the following are eligible to tender and must provide such proof:

- Original valid tax clearance certificate
- Company registration certificate
- Original certified copy of valid B-BBEE certificate (non-compulsory, failure to submit no points will be awarded)
- Valid proof of registration with CIDB on 6CE/6ME or higher.
