Bids will be pre-qualified in accordance with functionality criteria as outlined in the tender. Only the bids that meet the minimum number of 60 points out of the total number of points for functionality will proceed to the price and preference goals evaluation stage.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **at 12:00 on 18/04/2018**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.*

- If that person is not a natural person , of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state,
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity
