Tenders are hereby invited for the PHASE 1 OF THUSONG CENTRE AT SOMAPHEPHA, in the Steve Tshwete municipal region. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 6GB or higher.** The contract comprises mainly of construction work of Multi-purpose Centre in Somaphepha.

Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

**Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "TENDER NO. BS05/01/2018: PHASE 1 OF THUSONG CENTRE AT SOMAPHEPHA"** with the name of the tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before 12H00 on 05 March 2018. The tenders will be opened in public.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the **Cnr Walter Sisulu and Protea Road, Electrical Workshop Training Room, Service Centre (Magasyn), Middelburg, Mpumalanga, 1050** on **19 February 2018**, starting at **10:00 am** hrs. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

***Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby 70 points has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the supply chain management policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.***

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

**NB: Only locally produced or manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered in line with Regulation 8(2) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations and National Treasury Circular 69."**

**The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South-African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid; and**

**Only the South-African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 12863:2011 must be used to calculate local content.**

- **Original certified copy of valid BBBEE Certificate (non-compulsory, failure to submit no points will be awarded) only SANAS accredited or Affidavits will be accepted.**

- **Certified copy of Bank rating document (bids with a value above R2-million) - Compulsory**
- **Copy of current municipal account (not older than 3 months) – copy of Lease Agreement - Compulsory**
- **Company’s latest three years audited financial statements for bids with a value above R 10 million rand - Compulsory**
- **CSD summary report - Compulsory**
- **Registration with CIBD on 6GB or higher.**
- **Local content is applicable as per MBD 6.2.**
