PANEL OF MAXIMUM THREE (03) MECHANICAL CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT AT THE WATER AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS AS AND WHEN REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY SIX (36) MONTHS.

In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for the panel of maximum three (03) mechanical contractors to provide services for repair and maintenance of plant and equipment at the water and wastewater treatment works as and when required for a period of thirty six (36) months.

Tender documents and specifications are available and can be obtained from Ms. Rose Kalies, Legal & Administration Department, Room B207, Municipal Building, Corner Walter Sisulu and Wanderers Avenue, P.O. Payments can be made through bank guaranteed cheque payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality or cash.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00hrs** on **24/04/2018**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. Hereafter all bids will be public.

Fully completed tender documents, clearly marked "**Tender No. BS06/02/2018: PANEL OF MAXIMUM THREE (03) MECHANICAL CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT AT THE WATER AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS AS AND WHEN REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY SIX (36) MONTHS** with "**NAME of TENDERER**" must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the **tender box** on the **1st floor**, Steve Tshwete Municipality, Civic Centre, Corner Walter Sisulu and Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, **by no later than 12:00 on 24/04/2018** The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where **80 points** will be allocated in respect of price and **20 points** in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the Central Supplier Database;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

NB: Only locally produced or manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered in line with Regulation 8(2) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations and National Treasury Circular 69."

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The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South-African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid; and Only the South-African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 12863:2011 must be used to calculate local content.

Two (02) pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall be applied. Bids will be pre-qualified on criteriae for preferential procurement. Only bidders that meet the following pre-qualifying criteria shall be considered:

- Pre-qualifying criteria 1: Only Bidders with BBBEE Level 1 Certificate will be considered.
- Pre-qualifying criteria 2: Bidder shall sub-contract a minimum of 30% to an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by Black people living in Rural or under developed areas or townships.

The following documents have to be attached (Bidders that fail to submit documents indicated as compulsory will be disqualified)

- **Original certified copy of valid BBBEE Certificate - Compulsory, only SANAS accredited or Affidavits will be accepted.**
- **Copy of company registration certificate(CK) – Compulsory**
- **Copy of Bank rating for tenders more than R2 Million - Compulsory**
- **Copy/ printed Tax Clearance Certificate or Tax compliance status Pin to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status- Compulsory**
- **Copy of current municipal account (not older than 3 months) – copy of Lease Agreement – Compulsory**
- **CSD summary report – Compulsory**
- **Valid proof of registration with CIBD on 3ME or higher- Compulsory**
- **Local content is applicable as per MBD 6.2- Compulsory**
