In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for tenders for cross over (moral regeneration) function on 31st December 2018 – 01 January 2019 at Themba Senamela Stadium.

Payments can be made through bank guaranteed cheque payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality or cash.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00** on **13/11/2018**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. Hereafter all bids will be public.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the **Gerard Sekoto Library Auditorium, Cnr Walter Sisulu and Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, 1050** on **07/11/2018** starting at **10:00**. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

Fully completed tender documents, clearly marked "**Tender No. BS10/09/2018 : TENDER FOR CROSS OVER (MORAL REGENERATION) FUNCTION ON 31ST DECEMBER 2018 – 01 JANUARY 2019 at THEMBA SENAMELA STADIUM**" with "**NAME of TENDERER**" must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the **tender box** on the **1st floor**, Steve Tshwete Municipality, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, **by no later than 12:00 on 13/11/2018**. The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where **80 points** will be allocated in respect of price and **20 points** in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Only bidders who score a minimum of **70 points** on functionality will be further evaluated on price and BBEE.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the Central Supplier Database;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

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Pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall be applied. Bids will be pre-qualified on one (1) criteria for preferential procurement. Only bidders that meet the following pre-qualifying criteria shall be considered:

- Criteria 1: Only Bidders with a BBBEE Level 1 or Level 2 Certificate will be considered.

The following documents have to be attached (Bidders that fail to submit documents indicated as compulsory will be disqualified):

- Original certified copy of valid BBBEE Certificate - Compulsory (Only SANAS accredited or Affidavits will be accepted).
- Copy of company registration certificate (CK) - Compulsory
- Copy / print Tax compliance status Pin issued by SARS to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status- Compulsory
- Copy of current municipal account (not older than 3 months) – copy of Lease Agreement – Compulsory
- CSD summary report – Compulsory
