Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00hrs** on **26/03/2019**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. Hereafter all bids will be public.

No briefing session will take place.

Fully completed tender documents, clearly marked "**Tender No. BS12/01/2019; RE-ADVERT: TENDER FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF DENNESIG AND MIDDELBURG EXT 49 WASTE TRANSFER STATIONS FOR A PERIOD OF 24 MONTHS**" with "NAME of TENDERER" **must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box on the 1st floor, Steve Tshwete Municipality, Civic Centre, Corner Walter Sisulu and Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg**, by no later than 12h00 on **26/03/2019**. The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby 60 points has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the Central Supplier Database;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall be applied. Bids will be pre-qualified on the following criteria for preferential procurement. Only bidders that meet the following pre-qualifying criteria shall be considered:

- Criteria 1: Only Bidders with a BBEE Level 1 or Level 2 Certificate will be considered.
