THE APPOINTMENT OF A MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND OFF-LOADING OF LIME AND SLUDGE THICKENING POLYELECTROLYTE AS AND WHEN REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY SIX (36) MONTHS

In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for the appointment of a maximum of two (2) service providers for the supply, delivery and off-loading of lime and sludge thickening polyelectrolyte as and when required for a period of thirty six (36) months

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00hrs** on **2018/04/19**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. Hereafter all bids will be public.

Fully completed tender documents, clearly marked "**Tender No. BS12/02/2018: THE APPOINTMENT OF A MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND OFF-LOADING OF LIME AND SLUDGE THICKENING POLYELECTROLYTE AS AND WHEN REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY SIX (36) MONTHS**" with "**NAME of TENDERER**" must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the **tender box** on the **1ST floor**, Steve Tshwete Municipality, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, **by no later than 12h00 on 2018/04/19**. The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality **where 80 points** will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the Central Supplier Database;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

- **Two (2) pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall apply:**
- **Pre-qualifying criteria 1: Only tenderers having a minimum B-BBEE status level 1 shall be considered. Original certified copy of BBBEE certificate or sworn affidavit must be attached. A tender that fails to meet this criteria will not be considered.**
- **Pre-qualifying criteria 2: Only exempted micro enterprise (EME) or qualifying small business enterprise (QSE) of contributor shall be considered. A sworn affidavit for EME/QSEs (accessible from www.dti.gov.za) must be attached. A tender that fails to meet this criteria will not be considered.**
