Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality. Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "**TENDER NO. BS12/08/2017: SUPPLY, DELIVER AND INSTALLATION OF 3000m x 2.4m high CONCRETE PALISADE FENCE AT THE AIRFIELD**" with the name of the tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 1ST floor, Office B207, Civic Centre, Cnr Walter Sisulu & Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before 12H00 on 27 SEPTEMBER 2017. The tenders will be opened in public. A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the Steve Tshwete Municipality: Infrastructure offices, 14a SADC Street Middelburg on 14th September 2017, starting at 10:00 hrs. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the Project Manager will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby 70 points has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the supply chain management policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Contractors who have the following are eligible to tender and must provide such proof:

- **Original certified copy of valid B-BBEE certificate (non-compulsory, failure to submit no points will be awarded)**
- **Company registration certificate**
- **Valid Tax Clearance certificate & SARS Pin and reference number (Tax status must be tax compliant at closure of bid)**
- **Original Certified copy of current municipal account (not older than three months)**
- **Copy of CSD report must be attached**
- **Valid proof of registration with CIDB on 3SQ or higher.**
- **Original Certified copy of bank rating document (bids with a value above R2 million)**
