A non-compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the **MECHANICAL WORKSHOP, MAGASYN, CNR PROTEA AND WALTER SISULU STREET, MIDDELBURG** on 12/09/2019 starting at 10h00. Contract documentation will not be available on site,

*Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby **70 points** has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the supply chain management policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where **80 points** will be allocated in respect of price and **20 points** in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.*

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

NB: Only locally produced or manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered in line with Regulation 8(2) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations and National Treasury Circular 69."

The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South-African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid; and Only the South-African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 12863:2011 must be used to calculate local content.

Pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall be applied. Only bidders that meet the following pre-qualifying criteria shall be considered:

- Criteria 1: Only Bidders with a BBBEE Level 1 or Level 2 Certificate will be considered.

The following documents have to be attached (Bidders that fail to submit documents indicated as compulsory will be disqualified)

- **Original certified copy of valid BBBEE Certificate – (only SANAS accredited or Affidavits will be accepted) - Compulsory.**
- **Copy of company registration certificate(CK) - Compulsory**
- **Copy/ printed Tax compliance status Pin to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status- Non-Compulsory**
- **Copy of current municipal account (not older than 3 months) – copy of Lease Agreement – Compulsory**
- **CSD summary report – Non-Compulsory**
- **CIDB grading of 1CE to 3CE - Compulsory**
- **Local content is applicable as per MBD 6.2 as well as Annexure C and D- Compulsory**
- **Approval of exemption on local content from DTI must be attached with bidding document, as and when applicable – Compulsory**
- **Audited annual financial statements for the past 3 years for the Bid above R10m – Compulsory**
- **Joint Ventures must be registered on CSD as a Joint Venture**
