In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for the upgrading of the Boskrans Waste Water Treatment Works. Tenders are hereby invited for the **RE-ADVERTISEMENT: UPGRADING OF THE ELECTRICAL MOTOR CONTROL PANELS AT VAALBANK WATER TREATMENT PLANT** in the Steve Tshwete municipal region. The works comprises of the mechanical-electrical works. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 2ME or 2EP or higher.**

Tender documents will be obtainable on the 2018/04/03 during office hours, from Ms Rose Kalies, Department of the Director Legal & Administration, Room B207, Municipal Building, Wanderers Avenue, P.O. Box 14, Middelburg, Mpumalanga 1050, Tel: (013) 249-7365 & Fax: (013) 243-2550) against payment of a non-refundable tender amount of R500.00. Only bank guaranteed cheques or cash will be accepted. Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality. Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "**TENDER NO. BS17/03/2018 RE-ADVERTISEMENT: UPGRADING OF THE ELECTRICAL MOTOR CONTROL PANELS AT VAALBANK WATER TREATMENT PLANT**" with the name of the tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 1ST floor, Civic Centre, Cnr Walter Sisulu and Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before 12H00 on 2018/04/19. The tenders will be opened in public.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the Vaalbank WTP (29°28'57.67"E 25°49'14.81"S) MIDDELBURG on 2018/04/12 starting at 10h00. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby 70 points has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the supply chain management policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

- **Pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall be applied. Bids will be pre-qualified on two (2) criteria for preferential procurement. Only bidders that meet the following pre-qualifying criteria shall be considered:**
- **Criteria 1: Exempted Micro Enterprises (EME) or Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSE). A sworn affidavit for EME/QSEs (accessible from <http://www.dti.gov.za>) must be attached. A tender that fails to meet this pre-qualifying criteria stipulated is an unacceptable tender.**
- **Criteria 2: Only Bidders with BBEE Level 1 Certificate will be considered.**

The following documents have to be attached (Bidders that fail to submit documents indicated as compulsory will be disqualified):

- **Original certified copy of valid BBEE Certificate (non-compulsory, failure to submit no points will be awarded) only SANAS accredited or Affidavits will be accepted.**
- **Copy of company registration certificate(CK) - Compulsory**
- **Copy/ printed Tax Clearance Certificate or Tax compliance status Pin to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status- Compulsory**
- **Copy of current municipal account (not older than 3 months) – copy of Lease Agreement – Compulsory**

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- **CSD summary report – Compulsory**
- **Valid proof of registration with CIDB on 2ME or 2EP or higher- Compulsory**
- **Copy of Bank rating letter (Value of bid above R 2 million rand)**
- **Local content is applicable as per MBD 6.2 - Compulsory**
