## 2ND PHASE UPGRADING OF BOSKRANS WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT MATURATION PONDS – REFURBISHMENT OF POND 4 AND 5

In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for the Maturation pond earthworks at the Boskrans Waste Water Treatment Works.

Tenders are hereby invited for the **2ND PHASE UPGRADING OF BOSKRANS WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT MATURATION PONDS – REFURBISHMENT OF POND 4 AND 5**, in the Steve Tshwete municipal region. **Tenderers must have CIDB contractor grading of 3CEPE or higher.**

Tender documents will be obtainable during office hours, from 07/08/2018 from Ms Rose Kalies, Department of the Director Legal & Administration, Room B207, Municipal Building, Wanderers Avenue, P.O. Box 14, Middelburg, Mpumalanga 1050, Tel: (013) 249-7365 & Fax: (013) 243-2550) against payment of a non-refundable tender amount of R540,00. Only bank guaranteed cheques or cash will be accepted. Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked **"TENDER NO. BS18/07/2018: "2ND PHASE UPGRADING OF BOSKRANS WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT - MATURATION PONDS – REFURBISHMENT OF POND 4 AND 5"** with the name of the tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Room B207, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before 12H00 on 28/08/2018. The tenders will be opened in public.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the gate of the Boskrans WWTP (lat 25.738606°, long 29.449324°) MIDDELBURG on **16/08/2018**, starting at 10h00. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

*Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby **70 points** has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the supply chain management policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where **80 points** will be allocated in respect of price and **20 points** in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.*

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Contractors who have the following are eligible to tender and must provide proof of such:

- Pre-qualifying criteria for preferential procurement shall be applied. Bids will be pre-qualified on one (1) criteria for preferential procurement. Only bidders that meet the following pre-qualifying criteria shall be considered:
- Criteria 1: Minimum BBBEE Level 1 Certificate. **Original certified copy of valid SANAS Accredited BBBEE certificate/sworn affidavit must be attached. A tender that fails to meet this pre-qualifying criteria stipulated is an unacceptable tender.**
- **Tenderer has to subcontract a minimum of 30% to local sub-contractors for plant hire.**
- **Original certified copy of valid BBBEE Certificate (non-compulsory, failure to submit no points will be awarded) only SANAS accredited or Affidavits will be accepted.**
- **Copy of company registration certificate(CK) – Compulsory**
- **Copy/ printed Tax compliance status Pin to enable the municipality to verify the bidder's tax compliance status- Compulsory**
- **Joint ventures must be registered on CSD – Compulsory**
- **Copy of current municipal account (not older than 3 months) – copy of Lease Agreement – Compulsory**
- **CSD summary report – Compulsory**
- **Copy of Bank Rating for tenders above the amount of R 2 million – Compulsory**
- **Valid proof of registration with CIDB on 3CEPE or higher - Compulsory**
