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C3 SCOPE OF WORKS / SPECIFICATIONS

1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Steve Tshwete Local Municipality 's Boskrans waste water Treatment works operates with a 20 Ml Biological Nutrient Removal Reactor for the treatment of domestic and Industrial wastewater. Ten aerators dissolve oxygen into the reactor to keep the bacteriae alive while breaking-down organic matter and nirtyfying. The aerators also serve to keep the solids and bacterias in suspension and retained in the reactor for a particular period.

The amount of dissolved oxygen (DO) and the Mixed liquor Suspended Solids (MLSS) contained requires continuous monitoring and measurement for effective operation of the plant. This project aims to install the online DO and MLSS analysers.

2. TERMS OF REFERENCE

SPECIFICATIONS FOR ONLINE ANALYZERS

1. The system shall be a single-parameter analyzer capable of mesasuring up to minimum of two channels.The analyser must be able to measure and give display of the following parameters with the measuring units as shown below:
 - a. dissolved oxygen (mg/l)
 - b. suspended solids, (mg/l)
 - c. pH, (pH units)
 - d. temperature (°C)
 - e. and Oxydation Reduction Potential (ORP) in any combination.
2. It shall consist of the monitor, sensors, and mounting hardware.
3. The fluorescent DO sensor shall be a type that does not require membranes, cartridges, fill solutions, or replaceable membrane or sensor caps as these types of designs are not acceptable. The sensor shall not be damaged by exposure to direct or indirect sunlight nor will exposure to sunlight affect the calibration. The sensor will automatically compensate for temperature, salinity and altitude variations.
4. The SS sensor shall be a type that will automatically compensate for ambient light and any process color changes. The sensor will use a 880 nanometer emitter. The sensor will automatically compensate for temperature variations.
5. The pH electrode will be a flat glass, double reference junction with temperature compensation. The pH holder will have a built-in pre-amp and self-cleaning port to allow for air or water jet cleaning. No holder requiring external tubes or fittings to implement self cleaning will be accepted.
6. The ORP electrode will be a flat glass type of electrode. The ORP holder will have a built-in self-cleaning port to allow for air or water jet cleaning. No holder requiring external tubes or fittings to implement self cleaning will be accepted.
7. Supply of cabling (power and transmission cables) as per site requirements.

PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS:

1. The monitor shall be housed in a fiberglass enclosure with brackets for wall or standard round handrail mounting.
2. It shall have a digital display controlled by microprocessor circuitry.
3. All run, programming, and calibration functions shall be accessible without having to open the enclosure.
4. Unit shall be pre-calibrated at the factory.

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5. Provide a minimum of 1 setpoint relay output per sensor, an alarm relay output and a minimum of two self-cleaning relay outputs.
6. Provide an extended temperature, UV treated LCD digital display for continuously showing all sensor readouts. Programming and diagnostics are also provided through this display.
7. Provide self-diagnostics for the sensor and analyzer. Analyzer shall have error messages in the operating mode for higher or lower than normal sensor output voltage, temperature input outside the 0-60 degree C range, and unstable instrument circuitry; error messages in the calibrate mode for unstable sensor temperature (after a 5 minute wait), unstable output of the sensor (after a 5 minute wait), and weak sensor output level.
8. Provide isolated RS-485 MODBUS RTU serial communication port for all sensors and relay status.
9. Provide 4-20 mA isolated output for all sensors.

11. Display dissolved oxygen in ppm. The accuracy of the DO reading will be +/- 0.05 ppm. The repeatability of the DO sensor will be +/- 0.02 ppm.
