SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND SUPPORT FOR DIGITAL QUEUE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THIRTY-SIX(36) MONTHS In terms of Section 110 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (No. 56 of 2003), tenders are hereby invited for the **SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND SUPPORT FOR DIGITAL QUEUE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THIRTY-SIX(36) MONTHS**.

Box 14, Middelburg, Mpumalanga 1050, Tel: (013) 249-7365 & Fax: (013) 243-2550) against payment of a non-refundable tender amount of **R740,00**. Only payments made in cash or debit/credit card will be accepted.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00hrs** on **13/12/2022**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. Hereafter all bids will be public.

A non-compulsory clarification meeting will take place on 22/11/2022 starting at 10:00 at Library Auditorium, Gerard Sekoto Library, Cnr. Walter Sisulu Street and Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg.

Fully completed tender documents, clearly marked "**Tender No. BS17/10/2022: SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND SUPPORT FOR DIGITAL QUEUE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THIRTY-SIX(36) MONTHS**" with "NAME of TENDERER" **must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box** provided by **Steve Tshwete Municipality on the 1st floor, Room B 207, Civic Centre, Corner Walter Sisulu and Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg**, by no later than 12h00 on **13/12/2022**. The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby 60 points has to be attained before financial proposals can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the Central Supplier Database;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

NB: Only locally produced or manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered in line with Regulation 8(2) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations and National Treasury Circular 69."

The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South-African Reserve Bank (SARB) at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid; and
